All exhibit applications will be reviewed.

- All applications must be received at least **two weeks prior** to the conference date. Full payment must accompany the application. Written confirmation of acceptance will be sent to the organizational contact.
- The exhibit cancellation deadline is eight (8) days prior to the conference date. If written request is received in that time frame, SCLRC will refund the exhibit fee, less a \$500 processing fee. Cancellation requests received after that time will not be eligible for a refund.
- Exhibit space will be assigned at the seminar. Space must be occupied by **7:15 a.m. the day of the conference**. Failure to meet this deadline may cause forfeiture of your space and we may use or reassign the space without refund. Exhibitors who anticipate delays must notify the SCLRC representative.

CME GUIDELINES & POLICIES

CME Guidelines Related to Educational Grants, Exhibit Space and Promotional Activities

In compliance with the ACCME Standards for Commercial Support, arrangements for commercial exhibits or advertisements cannot influence planning or interfere with the presentation, nor can they be a condition of the provision of commercial support for CME activities.

- Exhibit and other promotional fees shall be separate and distinct from educational grants/commercial support.
- All exhibits must be in a room or area separate from the education and the exhibits will not interfere or in any way compete with the learning experience prior to, during, or immediately after the activity.
- Company representatives must refrain from holding any commercial discussions in the educational meeting room. All promotional activities including interviews, demonstrations, and the distribution of literature or samples must be made within the exhibitor's space. Canvassing or distributing promotional materials outside the exhibitor's rented exhibit space is not permitted.
- Representatives of a commercial interest may attend the CME activities at the discretion of SCLRC for the direct purpose of the representatives' own education. However, they may not engage in sales or marketing activities while in the classroom.

Seminar Modification or Cancellation

SCLRC reserves the right to modify the course's schedule or program as necessary. SCLRC also reserves the right to cancel this seminar, in which case a full refund of the registration/exhibit fees will be provided. We are unable to refund any travel costs (flight, hotel, etc.) in the case of a program cancellation.
